

GO MaD, THE Music and Dance Competition, Application and Parental Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made on the _____ of _____, 20_____

(Hereafter known as the "Artiste")

And: Futuresys Ltd, 70 Mainline Business Centre, Station Road, Liss Hampshire GU33 7AD (Hereafter known as the "Producer")

IT IS AGREED as follows:

1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1. In this Agreement, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

"Production"	The competition included as part of the entertainment show entitled "GO MaD, THE Music and Dance Competition".
"Website"	The website used to promote the Production. The address of which is www.madmusicdance.co.uk .
"Application"	The entry sent to The Producer from the Website by The Artiste.

2. Proposed Production

- 2.1. The Application made by the Artiste is for entry to the Production which the Producer proposes but does not undertake to produce.
- 2.2. By applying to enter the Production the Artiste agrees that any information given by them in their application may be used in the Production should they be selected.

3. Grant of Rights

- 3.1. The Artiste retains copyright to any music and/or lyrics they write.
- 3.2. The Artiste and their parent or legal guardian grant the Producer a worldwide, perpetual, non-exclusive, royalty-free and transferable licence (with the right to sub-license) to use, edit, reproduce, record, modify, translate, distribute, play, perform, make available to the other users of the Producer's online services (which may include audio visual content, text, photographs, forums, advertising and other services), prepare derivative works of and display the performances of the Artiste for, and in relation to, the Production by any medium or method whether now known or later developed to be exercised in the Producer's sole discretion throughout the world for the full term of copyright and other rights and all renewable and extension thereof PROVIDED however that in the event of such exploitation of the performance results in a payment of any kind or nature (excluding direct advertising on www.madmusicdance.co.uk itself, the sale of tickets and the sale of merchandise for the production including but not limited to clothing and memorabilia), the net profit or use of such payment or payment in kind shall be shared equally between the Producer, the Artiste and the Artiste's school of official enrolment at the time of such performance.

4. Rules

- 4.1. The Artiste acknowledges and agrees that they will abide by any and all rules, regulations, terms and conditions relating to the Application, the Production and their involvement in it (the "Rules"). They acknowledge and agree that the Rules are subject to change at any time by the Producer (whether in writing or verbally) and that agree to be bound by the Rules at all times. The Artiste acknowledges and agrees that the Producer's decision shall be final and binding upon them at all times.

4.2. When possible updated Rules will be posted on the Website.

4.3. The Artiste agrees that the selection for them to take part in the Production is at the discretion of the Producer and the judges whose decision will be final.

4.4. All personal details and/or information given in the application are truthful, accurate and in no way misleading.

4.5. If requested the Artiste will provide the Producer with documentation in order to substantiate their age (i.e. birth certificate and/or valid passport).

4.6. The Producer reserves the right to disqualify the Artiste if they have supplied untruthful, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information, have failed to abide by the Rules and/or are in breach of the terms hereof.

4.7. The Artiste will not, without the Producer's prior written consent, publicise or discuss with any third party any information relating to the Production, the production team or any participants in the Production nor any other information which may come to their attention (including without limitation in relation to the Producer or otherwise) save where such information is already public knowledge. For the purposes of this paragraph only a third party shall mean any person not participating in the Production.

4.8. The Artiste must disclose to the Producer details of any/all criminal/civil actions pending against them currently and/or served against them and/or any unspent convictions.

4.9. The Artiste will be responsible for bringing/arranging the use of any form of equipment required as part of their act and are responsible for ensuring that such equipment is safe and/or suitable for its purposes.

4.10. Pyrotechnics are not permitted.

4.11. The completion of an Application does not guarantee that the Artiste will be successful. If the Producer decides to take the Application to the next stage then the Artiste will be sent an invitation to audition through their school once audition dates have been confirmed. Due to the high volume of applications received the Producer will only notify successful applicants.

4.12. All successful Artistes may be asked to complete further agreements / releases in the course of their involvement in the Production.

5. Parental or Legal Guardian Permission

5.1. The Artiste must have the permission of their parents or legal guardians to take part in the Production.

5.1.1. The parent or legal guardian of the Artiste is required to sign this Agreement to confirm permission is granted by them for the Artiste to take part in the Production and that they agree with the contents of this Agreement.

5.2. By signing this agreement the parent or legal guardian of the Artiste also gives consent for the Artiste to use the online blogging facility on the website, www.madmusicdance.co.uk, that will be made available to their act if they successfully make it through the audition stage.
